

DRIVE Program Requirements

1. Completed DRIVE Application
2. Signed Release of Information Form
3. Obtain the following documents from the Department of Licensing (there is a \$10.00 charge for these documents)
 - A. Complete Driving Abstract
 - B. What is Holding Your License?
 - C. Eligibility Data
4. Provide proof of Income (current paystub or copy of award letter if receiving assistance)
5. The tickets holding the license must be from a county that participates in the DRIVE Program
6. Applicant must live in Kitsap County
7. The license must be suspended in the 3rd degree
8. If your license is suspended due to child support, you must clear this up prior to applying for the DRIVE Program. For help with child support contact: 1-866-243-4449
9. Attend the designated DRIVE Program Awareness Course on financial information and traffic/vehicle safety topics.

DRIVE Program Disqualifiers

1. The program ***does not*** pay for license renewals, driving schools or any fees or charges required by the Department of Licensing
2. The program ***does not*** help with Occupational Licenses
3. The program ***does not*** help if your license is suspended due to a DUI
4. The program ***does not*** help if you have had a DUI within the last three years
5. If you have had multiple DUI's you may not qualify for the program. Such cases will be reviewed on an individual basis
6. The program ***does not*** help if your license is suspended in another state
7. The program ***does not*** help if your tickets are from courts that do not work with the DRIVE Program.
