Qualifications:

- Must work and have earned income
- Social Security number and card for each person on the tax return
- Not file as “married filing separate,”
- Not file Form 2555 or Form 2555-EZ (related to Foreign Earned Income)
- Investment income limited to \$3,100
- Not be the qualifying child of another person
- Generally, must be a U.S. citizen or resident alien for the entire year

Income Eligibility Guidelines

Earned income and adjusted gross income (AGI) must each be less than:

- \$43,352 or (\$48,362 married filing jointly) with 3 or more qualifying children
- \$40,363 or (\$45,373 married filing jointly) with 2 qualifying children
- \$35,535 or (\$40,545 married filing jointly) with 1 qualifying child
- \$13,460 or (\$18,470 married filing jointly) with no qualifying children

What you need to bring:

- **Social security card** for each person on the tax return
- **Photo identification**
- **All 2010 tax documents, statements for all sources of income (W2,1099, etc.)**
- **Copy of last year's tax return**
- **Childcare provider name, address and tax ID number**
- **Bank account and routing number for direct deposit (if applicable)**
