Krystal and her disabled son

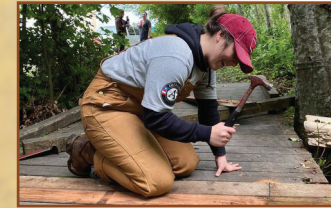
moved here after fleeing domestic violence. They had a place to stay with a friend, but it did not work out.

Krystal and her child stayed homeless for over two years. She was unable to work full time with her son's around the clock care.

Through KCR's Project Based Voucher program, they received long term and supportive housing. Both are safe, healthy, and currently enrolled in distance learning as they stabilize.

With the support of KCR donors, Krystal and her son received clothes and toys, food boxes to supplement nutrition, and furniture and household items.

Finally, after over two years of living in the car and in shelters, Krystal and her son are in a safe place, ready to make a new start.

Affordable Housing Project in Manette

Kitsap Community Resources is soon underway with new construction of a nine unit townhouse triplex. The complex will accommodate low-income families with children. Each unit will offer 1,500 square feet of living space with one two-bedroom unit ADA accessible.

The project is located close to public transportation, schools, childcare, grocery stores, health clinics, parks, and the ferry.
