KCR Board Hires Interim Executive Director Anstey to Support Organization and Board of Directors

Kitsap Community Resources is in the process of hiring its next Executive Director. To ensure that the Board of Directors has ample time and all the necessary resources, the Board has engaged Gina Anstey as Interim Executive Director with Irmgard Davis as KCR Fiscal Officer. Gina will work to support the organization by creating a roadmap that enables a smooth transition for the permanent Executive Director. The search process for that position is underway.

Gina has 16 years of involvement in the nonprofit sector, most of them creating deep knowledge and experience in community philanthropy. Prior to launching her consultancy, she spent 12 years as part of leadership at the Greater Tacoma Community Foundation in Pierce County. Locally, she recently completed an interim CEO assignment with the Kitsap Community Foundation.

KCR Board Chair Tracy Flood says, “The board is committed to ensuring the success of the permanent leader. Our agency was created out of community action, with dedication to creating hope and opportunity for low-income Kitsap County families. We believe that bringing in Gina offers the board and staff the best support, time and space to lay the groundwork for success.”

KCR is a dynamic partner in the Kitsap County Community. KCR touches 10% of the 277,000 residents of Kitsap County’s population through a variety of programs. The organization’s services and programs includes Housing and Homelessness services; Veteran’s assistance; WIC (Women Infant Children) nutritional food program; Early Head Start and Head Start; WIOA (Workforce Innovation Opportunity Act); BE\$T (Business Education Support Training); GED instruction and testing; job training and placement services; food services for Meals on Wheels Kitsap and early learning centers; Weatherization; Energy assistance; and other community support services. KCR operates 11 sites throughout Kitsap County.
