BE\$T Business Basics Application Process

Thank you for your interest in attending our business training program. The first step is to fill out the preapplication form on our website and if you are accepted you will be sent the application forms to fill out online.

Tuition Fees: The BE\$T program operates on a sliding scale tuition fee. We use your total household income to determine eligibility based on the number of people in your household. Income guidelines are based upon what your household income is *at the time you apply*.

Income Verification: If you are accepted into the Business Basics class, you will need to provide proof of income for the **three months** prior to the first day of class. We ask for:

- Proof of income for each household income source (see list below)
- HUD Self Certification form. (this will be emailed to you, to check and sign after you submit your application)

Verification of income for the last three months (prior to class start month)

Please provide supporting documents for **one** of the following:

- Employment paystubs or payroll printout
- Public assistance EBT (food stamps) /TANF Award letter or history report
- **Unemployment**: you can request a history report from Employment Security at the Worksource office if you do not have access to a printer
- Self-employment Business license, bank statements, business earnings
- Social Security, SSI, Veterans Benefits, Pension, Retirement, Annuity, 401K award letter that covers the 3 months prior to class start date
- Bank Statements (or screenshots of last 3 months if you bank online)
